## Religious Unity?

"Can two walk together, except they be agreed?" Amos 3:3. Then, because of societal influences and the push for tolerance on every hand, are we as Christians to adopt an attitude of "Peace At Any Price"? Is that a religious "unity" that is acceptable to God?

In the 1st century AD, the apostle Paul (2nd Timothy 2:17-19) identified as false teachers, those who believed and taught that the resurrection was already past. In our day of tolerance and political correctness, Paul would be urged to not be so harsh and mean-spirited. He would no doubt be told, "That's just your opinion or interpretation." However, Paul plainly stated that they had erred; that they had overthrown the faith of others, and that those two (Hymenaeus & Philetus) must depart from iniquity. Those individuals, having erred, overthrown faith, and being in iniquity were lost - condemned, and had fallen from grace. In 1st Timothy 1:20, Paul "delivered unto Satan" Hymenaeus and Alexander. Friends, there can be no question that these false teachers and those in doctrinal error were in an eternally lost condition. They stood eternally condemned, unless they repent and turn back to God. Nowhere do we find that they did, anymore than Judas did.

When we consider the plain New Testament teaching about those who are in doctrinal error, do we dare just say that one faith is as good as another? Do we dare accept that one church is as good as another, despite the wide disparity of doctrinal practices? We dare not without endangering our soul's destiny. Can we then safely advocate some kind of religious "union" whereby 'brethren' maintain a "peace" that is a sham rather than genuine? No! Dare we state that matters of faith and differences in doctrine may be laid aside that denominational 'brethren' then might have a kind of "peace"? No! We have previously stated that one factor contributing to division is the failure to study and understand what constitutes matters of faith (on which no leeway can be given) and what constitutes matters of opinion (wherein liberty can be granted). The peace that is pleasing to the Lord can be attained, and maintained, only if would-be 'brethren' will abide by the doctrine of the Christ!

The Lord has provided that there must be no fellowship with those who depart from the faith (Matt. 18:17; 1st Cor. 5; Rom. 16:17; 2nd Thess. 3:14; and Titus 3: 10). We must attempt to restore them (Galatians 6:1-4), but not maintain fellowship. Yet, there can be no "peace" at any price regardless of whether political correctness is breached. Political correctness is not the Christian's guide to reach Heaven! Nor can there be silence concerning doctrinal transgression of God's Word, wherein God demands a rebuke of a false teacher. Rather, obedience to His will as SUPREME demands that faithful Christians take as bold a stand as the apostle Paul took. If the erring are willing to repent, then the unity Jesus prayed for can be attained. If we hold loyally to the Book, when division comes, the fault is not chargeable to us. In Paul's words "Endeavor to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Eph. 4:3). May we give our all to doing just that!
