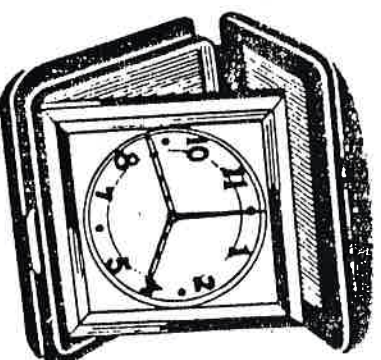

The Question No One Asks

"Moreover thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord; Shall they fall, and not arise? shall he turn away, and not return? Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return. I hearkened and heard, but they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle. Yea, the stork in the heaven knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the Lord." Jeremiah 8:4-7

God explains the reason for the Babylonian captivity into which the nation of Judah would be taken. No one repented. No one asked, "What have I done?" When no one is willing to take responsibility for what they have done, we have today the very reason behind God's discipline of the nation of Judah. Are you willing to ask the question no one is willing to ask? "What have I done?" Instead of blaming others, we need to inspect ourselves.

1. What have I done with Jesus? Denied Him as did Peter? Betrayed Him as did Judas? Confessed Him as did the Ethiopian treasurer? Obeyed Him as all must (Hebrews 5:8,9)? Followed Him?
2. What have I done with the church? Do I attend her services? Do I support her activities? Am I actively engaged in her work? Do I teach, visit, restore the erring? Teach the lost?
3. What have I done with the Bible? Do I read it? Do I study it? Am I obedient to it? Do I communicate it with others?
4. What have I done with prayer? Has it resulted in moved mountains? Have I prayed for the elders, preacher, deacons, teachers? Do I pray for the lost, erring, weak, members?
5. What have I done with God's message, the gospel? Am I concerned with getting it around the world? Around the city? Around my neighborhood? Around my house?
6. What have I done with God's warning? Do I know there are two ways and gates - narrow and wide. That there are two trees - bad fruit and good fruit. That there are two foundations - sand or rock. That there are two eternities - heaven or hell.

Who is willing to ask the question no one asks? What have I done?
