Liberalism Is Basically Dishonest

The philosophy of liberalism is inherently dishonest for it uses honest terms to convey error. While "fellowship" means sharing of Christian love with others who are saved and are faithful children of God, liberals use the term to embrace all people who call themselves "Christians," even when they, not only have not obeyed the Gospel, but are not loyal.

"Dialogue" is the bold confrontation of error with truth, but to the liberal it means giving the doctrines of men equal time with truth without the exposure of the error.

"Relevant preaching" is declaring the whole counsel of God as revealed in the Bible. But the liberal means discussions on ecology, social injustice, politics, etc., to the neglect of sin and salvation.

"Tolerance" means ignoring doctrinal error and allowing each to go his own way without rebuke when wrong, while Biblical tolerance is the forbearance of one another in love regarding those matters of mere human opinion.

Good words are being used cunningly to teach vicious falsehood. Appearing pious and humble, the practitioners of such dishonesty have "crept in unawares" and subverted entire congregations even sounding superficially sound. His vocabulary sounds "as the oracles." But the message he is really expounding is foreign to the truth.

Christ warned, "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly are ravening wolves" (Matthew 7:15).
