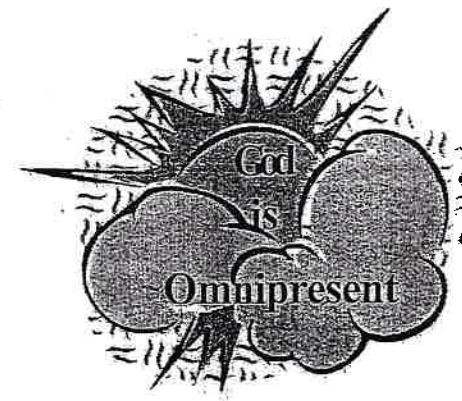

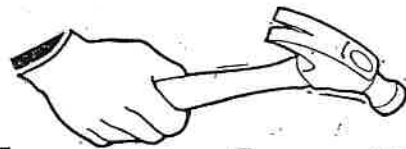

Our Pantry Item this week is Bleach. Last Week it was Laundry Detergent. We need more to participate in this effort. Put it on your grocery list, then you won't forget.

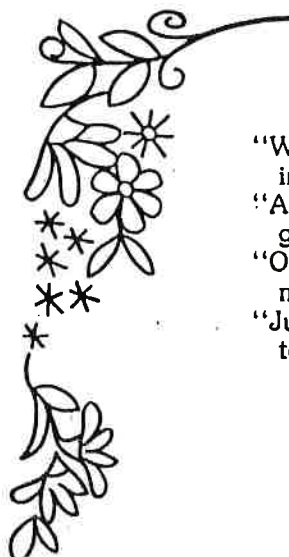
