## Loopholes

Loopholes are means of escape. They provide ways to evade the intent of some law, contract, or obligation. Through some ambiguous statement or omission from a text, a way out is provided. But listen to our Lord. "I am the way, the truth and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6). There are no loopholes here. For a person to misunderstand the Gospel plan of salvation, he would have to try.

One continuing problem about our tax structure in the United States is the problem of loopholes. Of course, if you are the one attempting to make use of the loophole, there is no problem. But some individuals spend more time looking for loopholes than they do figuring how much tax they owe. Corporations hire experts to look for legal ways to avoid taxes – and they find them. The result is the loss of millions of dollars to the United States government – all because of loopholes.

Some people develop "loophole mentality" in their relationship to God. I have heard that when the silent screen star and early TV personality, Groucho Marx, was on his deathbed, a visitor to his home found him reading the Bible. Asked what he was doing, he said, "Looking for loopholes, my friend. Looking for loopholes."

The Bible records that Jesus is the only way to heaven (Jon 14:6), and that we must repent of sins, confess Him, be baptized into His body (I Corinthians 12:12-13), and arise to walk in newness of life (Romans 6:3-4). But many people secretly feel that when they die and stand before the judgment bar they will find some other way to enter heaven. They refuse to accept or to believe the teachings of the Bible that salvation is through Christ alone, and that eternal punishment awaits those who refuse to obey the Gospel. They have convinced themselves that they will somehow escape the final judgment and its terrible consequences. BUT THEY ARE WRONG! Christ is the only way to heaven. All other ground is sinking sand.
