The Sinner's Prayer

In his recent autobiography, Heartbreak & Triumph, professional wrestler Shawn Michaels tells how he became a "born again" Christian by saying "The Sinner's Prayer" (pp.311-314). Mr. Michaels goes on to relate how this prayer is made up of three parts inclusive of confessing you are a sinner, professing your faith in Christ, and then accepting Jesus as your personal Savior. He further states that whereas he was baptized "as part of my rebirth" it is actually the saying of the "Sinner's Prayer" that saves you. As sincere and honest as Mr. Michaels might be in his newfound religion I must say with the deepest sympathy that he is woefully mistaken in this matter.

Nowhere on any page of the New Testament did any inspired apostle ever tell any alien sinner to utter a prayer in order to be saved. This is simply not what the Bible teaches. I will offer one thousand dollars to anyone who can find any such passage within the Bible. Mr. Michaels has accepted the erroneous denominational concept of salvation by "faith only." This is the idea that when you make the mental decision to accept Jesus into your heart as your personal Savior that at that moment you are saved, without any other acts of obedience.

Jesus did speak of the necessity of one being "born again" (John 3:3-5). But this happens when one is "born of water and the Spirit" to enter God's kingdom, Christ's church. This spiritual birth takes place when the penitent individual confesses their faith in Christ and is immersed in the watery grave of baptism in order to be raised with Christ to walk a new life. When those on the day of Pentecost asked what they must do to be saved from the consequences of their own sins Peter did not instruct them to utter a so-called Sinner's Prayer. Such a concept is foreign to the preaching of the apostles and must be considered false doctrine by every sincere student of the Bible. Rather, Peter told his audience of sin stricken believers to "repent and be baptized for the remission of your sins," (Acts 2:38). The Bible then informs is that those who "gladly received his word were baptized," (Acts 2:41). This is how people obeyed the gospel and were saved under the preaching of inspired apostles. Make sure not to allow yourself to be deceived by the denominational errors of the day such as the bogus "Sinner's Prayer."
