## "Foolishness" versus "The Power of God"

Paul said, "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God," (I Corinthians 1:18). No matter how much time and energy the worldly wise and intellectual scholars of the world expend, they could not combine their brilliance and arrive at the gospel plan for man's redemption. The necessity of salvation and the way to enjoy it is a matter of Divine revelation. Man, in and of himself, could never arrive at a satisfactory plan for relieving the burden of sin for an enjoyable life here and for preparation for eternity in hope. "O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his own steps." (Jeremiah 10:23). Man has always needed God's help, instruction, and guidance. Man has always had that help, instruction, and guidance. Sadly, there has always been a large percentage of lost human beings with feelings of self-sufficiency who scoff at such caring directives as "foolishness," and refuse to follow the "good way" to which God is calling mankind (Jeremiah 6:16).

The cry of many today, even brethren, is to invent and promote a more pleasing message. Away with the restrictions, obligations, and detailed order that appears as foolishness to the perishing. Jazz up the message and messenger. After all, people are not attracted to religion that places demands upon them and calls for radical changes in their attitudes and actions. Few have accepted that and few will ever. What is really being said by such proponents of fake care and concern is this: "Let the perishing tell you what they will accept and then give it to them. Ask the lost what they would be willing adhere to and supply what they want. I mean, if the real message of the cross is foolishness to them, water it down, weaken it, change it so more will swallow it."

The error of such a promotion is that when it is watered down it has lost its saving power. It is not the power of God, the truth, when it ceases being the truth. The truth saves and frees (John 8:31,32) and nothing else does. Why don't we just see to it that the gospel is preached and those who really want to be saved by it, with honest and good hearts, will hear what they need to hear? Anything less than that would be condemnation.

That is the purpose of our gospel meeting.
