BURIAL OF A DONKEY

The prophet Jeremiah quoted the Lord by saying, "Therefore thus says the LORD concerning Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah: They shall not lament for him, Saying, Alas, my brother!' or 'Alas, my sister!' They shall not lament for him, Saying, 'Alas, master!' or 'Alas, his glory!' He shall be buried with the burial of a donkey, Dragged and cast out beyond the gates of Jerusalem" (Jeremiah 22:18,19) [NKJV]. Keep in mind that the passage is talking about the king of Judah. When he dies, he will be buried like a donkey that has been dragged out of the city and cast aside. There will not be a lot of lamentation for him at his death. There will not be a funeral with pomp and ceremony. All the dignitaries will not parade past his coffin. There will not be a large stone erected to mark his burial place. Jehoiakim will have the burial of a donkey. Later Jeremiah would state, "Therefore thus says the Lord concerning Jehoiakim king of Judah: 'He shall have no one to sit on the throne of David, and his dead body shall be cast out to the heat of the day and the frost of the night' " (Jeremiah 36:30).

Throughout the book of Jeremiah you find the reason for these things happening to the leaders of Judah as well as the people. They refused to listen or to obey what God has told them to do. Jehoiakim was the son of Josiah, who was a just and righteous king. Jehoiakim and his brothers are described in Jeremiah 22:17 as being men who have eyes and heart only for dishonest gain, for shedding innocent blood, and for practicing oppression and violence.

God had been trying to use Jeremiah to get the message across that they must do the will of God. "I spoke to you in your prosperity, But you said, 'I will not hear.' This has been your manner from your youth, That you did not obey My voice" (Jeremiah 22:21). It is so important that we listen to what God's word says and obey it from our youth. Sad to read of a king having the burial of a donkey.
