The Power Of God's Word

Maybe we need to be reminded that there is saving power in the word of God. Sometimes we are prone to miss/forget the obvious. An angel said to Cornelius, "Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter; Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved." (Acts 11:13,14). Do you think that the process has changed for our day? In James 1:21 we can still read "Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness (overflowing of wickedness, ASV), and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls." Is it any wonder that Paul would say, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith," (Romans 1:16,17).

But let us dig a little deeper. The power is not in the physical materials of which the Bible is made, is it? The power that leads men to Christ, and that leads men and women to follow in the steps of the Savior are the thoughts, the motives, the ideas presented in the word of God. There is real power in a thought and great power in motive. It is by words that men move men, even whole armies and nations. The less than perfect thoughts of mere men have been powerful enough to throw down kingdoms.

If we want people to act a certain way, we try to fill them with thoughts and motives tending to lead them in the direction we want them to go. Friends and brethren, that is the purpose behind every sermon I preach. I would contend that this is the reason why we have Bible classes, VBS, gospel meetings, lectureships, Bible camp, etc. If we can fill people full of the ideas God has provided and the thoughts of God, we will induce them to do God's will. In this way God works in people to get them to live different lives. It is through the mighty power of the word that men are drawn to Christ (John 6:44,45).

For people, yes even brethren, to turn their back on God's ideas and thoughts, for whatever reason, simply insures that they have cut themselves off from the power: the power to live faithfully with and for God and brethren. The power of God's word! Tap into it today.
