# Wrested Scripture: John 14:26

The words of the Lord recorded in this passage are these: "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you." This passage is distorted today when people try to extend this promise beyond the apostles to whom Jesus spoke these words. By taking this verse out of its context and trying to make it apply to anyone other than those to whom Jesus was speaking is a wresting of Scripture. Jesus did not promise you or me or anyone so claiming today what He promised exclusively to the apostles. What God has given us is the inspired record through which all things pertaining to salvation are made known (I Corinthians 2:8-13; II Timothy 3:16,17; II Peter 1:3). No uninspired person ever learned a single spiritual truth but through the words of the Bible. When people begin to imagine that their hunches and feelings and dreams are the leadings of the Holy Spirit, they do not hesitate to repudiate the clear and undeniable teaching of the Spirit through the New Testament - the only certain teaching of the Spirit - in the pursuit of their own fanciful fantasies. When people give up the word of God as the only direction and guidance of the Spirit, what is the result? You end up with the chaotic contradictory confusions that are presently promoted and paraded before the world as if they were Christianity. They're not, because God is not the author of confusion (I Corinthians 14:33). Where disorder and discrepancy reign, God's hand is not in it. Don't you think that it's time to get back to the Bible?
