THE PERSIAN WAS/IS RIGHT!

There is a Persian proverb that sounds very much like a twister for the tongue rather than sound advice. Read it at least two times.

"He who knows not, and knows not that he knows not is a fool; shun him.

He who knows not, and knows that he knows not, is a child; teach him.

He who knows and knows not that he knows, is asleep; wake him.

He who knows, and knows that he knows, is wise; follow him."

Now all four "types" of people can be found in any business, on every campus, in every neighborhood, and in every congregation. They will not walk up to you and say, "Hi, I'm Donald and I'm a fool." The last thing he will want you to know is that "he knows not that he knows not."

Then how are we to know whom to shun, teach, awaken, or to follow? Discernment is the answer. There is the need of skill and accuracy in reading character; the ability to detect and identify the real truth; to see beneath the surface and correctly "size up" the situation. Yes, the need to read between the lines of the visible.

When God told Solomon to ask what he would and his wish would be granted, the king responded: "...give thy servant an understanding heart to judge they people, to discern between good and evil," (I Kings 3:9).

How can we have this great quality of life?

(1) Go to God in prayer. God promises wisdom to those who ask for it (James 1:5).

(2) God to the Word of God (Psalm 119:98-100). This will give you much insight.

(3) Go to wise people. Discernment is easier caught than taught.

We never outgrow our need for a good balanced growth in Christ. Be a faithful Christian.
