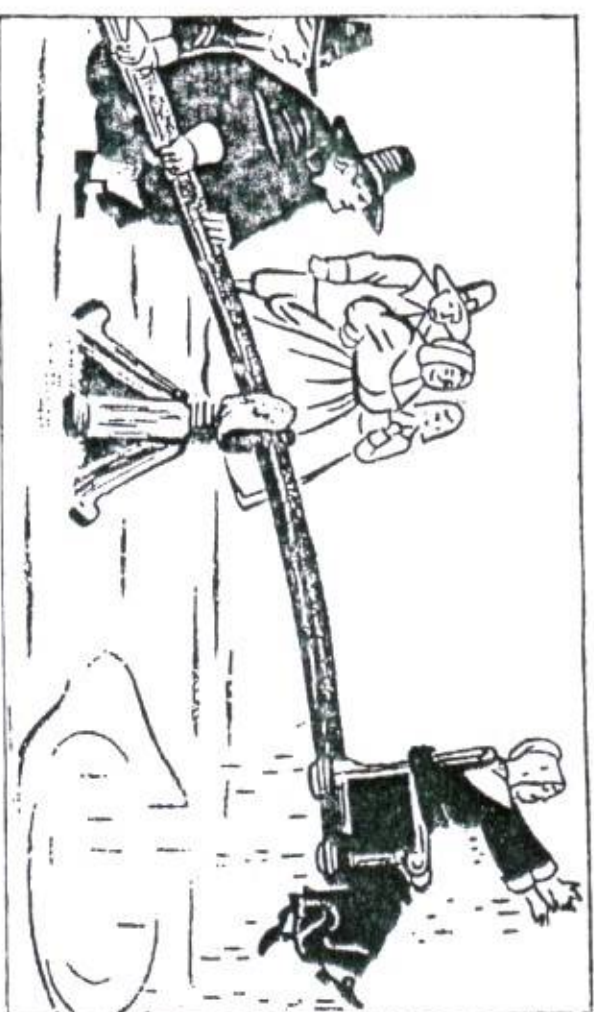

The article stated that the ducking stool was brought from England in the 1600's and was used for punishing gossips. The guilty party was ducked in a pond several times.

It is a pity that we no longer consider gossip a serious crime against God and mankind. If the ducking stool were still used, I'm sure that we all would have our wet days. Gossip has the power to ruin lives, rob happiness, create division, and break hearts. No wonder Paul said, "...study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your hand..." (1 Thessalonians 4:11). God's remedy for gossip is to go to our brother and gather the facts of the matter (Matthew 18:15) and not against our brother (James 4:11).

Try for one day not to say anything degrading about anyone. It may be a bigger challenge than you think. Nobody has all the facts on anyone. Second hand information can be as dangerous as dynamite. Circumstances are not always what they appear to be. What happened to "innocent until proven guilty" and "give them the benefit of the doubt."

As people who have been "ducked" in the name of Christ, let us use our tongues to His glory, knowing that every idle word will be accounted for (Matthew 12:36).
