Introduction

- 1. The last and closing chapter of the sermon on the mount.
- 2. Jesus teaches, warns, admonishes His people.
- 3. 'The marvelous "Golden Rule' is found in this chapter (v 12).
- 4. Note the "twos" of this chapter:
 - a. Two gates and two ways
 - b. Two trees, two men and two houses
- Jesus tells us about a wise man and a foolish man.



Select Verses

- 7:1 "Judge not, that ye be not judged."
- 7:7 "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you."
- 7:12 "Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets."
- 7:13-14 "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: (14) Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it."
- 7:15 "Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves."
- 7:21 "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven."
- 7:24-27 "Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock...."
- 7:29 "For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes."
