Introduction

- 1. The earthly ministry of Christ proves His Divinity.
 - a. He healed the lame.
 - b. He raised the dead.
 - He calmed the raging sea.
- Jesus invites ALL to follow Him but there is a COST that must be paid.
- The world sought to hear Him and see His amazing miracles. At times the whole city came to meet Jesus.



Select Verses

- 8:2 "And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean."
- 8:8 "The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed."
- 8:10 "When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel."
- 8:20 "And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head."
- 8:26 "And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm."

Select Thoughts / Themes

 After Jesus preached the sermon on the mount, multitudes followed Him. A leper worshiped Him, asking to be deansed (vs 1-4).

- Others came to be healed, or to have their dear ones healed. Jesus saw and commended them, especially the centurion's faith (who was a Gentile) (v 10).
- One of the reasons for healing by Jesus was to fulfill the prophecies (Esaias, v 17).
- Some in the first century STATED they wanted to follow Christ but were unwilling to pay the cost necessary to be a Christian (19-22).
 - Serving Christ may mean doing without worldly things.
 - Obeying Christ comes before even our family.
- In the storm the disciples were afraid (v 25). Fear can show the little faith we have in our Lord.
