- 4:1 ~ "Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil."
- 4:3-4 "And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. <sup>(4)</sup> But he answered and

said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

- 4:11 ~ "Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him."
- 4:17 "From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."
- 418-19 ~ "And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. <sup>(19)</sup> And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."
- 4:23 "And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan."
