## “He Looked Just Fine”

On July 3, 1997, Dr. Raymond Damadian's invention was used for the first time on a human subject. He conceived the idea for his amazing device in the 1960s and later authored a scientific paper in 1971. After obtaining a patent, he began developing and testing the equipment. As the machine lit up and resonated with a loud knocking, his volunteer assistant was probed. Suddenly, vivid colorful images of the assistant's heart, lungs, aorta, cardiac chamber, and chest wall appeared on the screen – without harsh radiation. Since then, tens of thousands of lives have been saved by early cancer detection and other medical diagnoses using Dr. Damadian's nuclear magnetic resonance scanner, otherwise known as an MRI. Seeing the true condition inside the body with this remarkable device enables doctors to prescribe treatments or lifestyle changes that may save a life. The frequent casual misdiagnosis, “He looked just fine,” may be avoided with the internal insight obtained with an MRI.

Access to various sound reading publications like the Spiritual Sword and our Bible classes can provide Meaningful Righteous Introspection with God's word. Don't let it be said of you, “He looked just fine.”
