This IS Not A Hamburger Stand

The call came on a Sunday morning and the person on the other end of the line asked, "How long will your services last and do you serve the Lord's supper first or last?" They were probably traveling and looking for something similar to drive through service. Quick and convenient is what much of the public demands in everything, including religion.

It's the Burger King mentality, i.e. "Have it your way." Many religious leaders have accepted it too and have incorporated it into their bag of gimmicks, but the Lord's church is not a hamburger stand. The church of the Lord is the body of Christ. Many may yield to the temptation of fast food approach, but it would be deadly to the church.

Instead of "hold the pickles" it has become in many places "hold the water, the doctrine, the preaching, and the singing." We are not at liberty to hold back what God has provided in the spiritual feast He has spread which includes all of the above. While many cry for change, adaptation, accommodation, and conformation lest we die. If we were to follow their advice, we would be dead while alive (I Timothy 5:6). There is no more spineless thing in the world than a liberal. It takes no conviction or intestinal fortitude to be one. Also realize that nothing good has ever resulted from liberalism.

We are not in the growth business. That is not our priority. We sow, plant, and water while God gives the increase. Some will not endure sound doctrine. Paul said it would be that way, II Timothy 4:2.3. He also said that they would want it their way instead of the Lord's. What was his inspired recommendation? Preach the word!

Nor are we in the people pleasing business. There is no clearer statement about that than Galatians 1:10, "If I were yet pleasing men, I should not be the servant of Christ." "Preach Christ" was his charge and ours. Maybe the church is like a hospital emergency room where men and women from all walks of life come in sick, hurt, bleeding, and dying. Yet they all ask for the same thing - please help me. They don't ask to have it their way. They are not concerned about how long it takes. They don't ask for a soft mattress or ask the temperature of the room. They don't notice whether the carpet and the curtains match. They don't walk out because there is someone in the next bed they don't like. They don't go back home because nobody spoke to the them. They don't gripe because of the color of the jacket the doctor has on.

Until we can convince the world of its sick and dying spiritual condition and the Great Physician in on call among us people will continue to be picky. The prodigal son was too until he came to himself, headed home, and said, "Make me a servant." We must not give in to a spoiled, pampered, indulgent generation. If we are the Lord's church, we are not a hamburger stand.
